Lancaster man struck by delivery truck on Walden Avenue

A 48-year-old Lancaster man was seriously injured when struck by a delivery truck on Walden Avenue near Central Avenue shortly after 7 p.m.

Lancaster police closed Walden Avenue for about a half-mile between Central Avenue and Ellicott Place until about 10 p.m. The victim is in serious condition at a local hospital, authorities said. Charges had not been filed late Tuesday. The man's identity was unavailable.

The accident comes on the heels of the death of a man who died after being struck by a car on Genesee Street in Cheektowaga about 5:30 p.m. Monday. The fatality occurred on Genesee, between Ellwood Place and Wheaton Drive.

The victim, described as only a Cheektowaga resident in his late 20s, was pronounced dead in Erie County Medical Center. No charges were lodged.
