Dear Mr. Fudoli,

This letter pertains to the rezone petition for 6525 and 6529 Broadway from neighborhood business to general business as discussed during the August 3, 2015 Lancaster Town Board Meeting. We understand this site needs to be sold and developed but a building smaller than the proposed 9100 square foot Dollar General would be much more appropriate.

We did speak at the August 3rd public hearing but wish to reiterate our concerns regarding this petition. The rezone required to build this Dollar General allows this too large building to be built on less than an acre lot. The five variances required permits the building to be placed five feet from the neighbor on the West! In addition, there are too few parking spaces and building size variances. (possibly there are wet land variances, not sure as these variances are difficult to determine from our paperwork). We have concerns regarding the increased traffic this building will cause (including tractor trailer delivery trucks as well as refuse trucks). Town Line Road and Broadway is a very busy intersection and this will only add to that congestion. Nearby is a closed small general store that struggled to stay in business. I worry that the Dollar General's business will also fail and close leaving a huge empty building on this lot. We have lived at 728 Town Line Road for 28 years and have had to endure many painful years of empty, deteriorating buildings on this same site. I certainly hope this doesn't happen again. We also feel this building is too close to our property line; so close in fact, that there is no room to even build a berm on the site. Our lovely trees may have their life compromised during the construction process. These trees provide a screen from Broadway noise and traffic and, if lost, cannot be replaced by a simple six foot fence. These concerns should not be ignored.

In closing, please don't forget that the Lancaster Town Planning Board was not unanimous in their decision as they barely passed it with a 4 to 3 vote. Please thoughtfully consider whether this will benefit our community. We feel this represents another "spot" rezone to accommodate a developer's plans. We would love to see Town Line improved aesthetically but shoehorning an unattractive Dollar General Store into this small site will do nothing to beautify Town Line.
