GAMES

- 1.) Each game will be seven innings in length, unless tied, and then extra innings will be played.
- 2.) A game shall be terminated if a team is winning by 15 runs or more at any time after the fifth inning. If the home team is leading by 15, it does not bat in the bottom of the inning. If the visitor is up by 15 or more, the home team gets its last ups.
- 3.) All regular season games begin at 6:45pm. A team failing to be ready within 15 minutes will forfeit the game at the discretion of the umpire. The Recreation Department reserves the right to start games earlier including doubleheaders at 6:15pm or earlier. Games may be played into September.
- 4.) Second team listed on schedule is home team.

POSTPONEMENTS

- 1.) The umpire assigned to the game shall be the sole judge of whether conditions are playable.
- 2.) If a game is postponed at the site or before it becomes a legal game, the home team must submit a scorecard with the umpire's signature, the status of the game, and why it was postponed.
- 3.) On rain days, Managers only should contact the Recreation office after 4:15pm to check on the status of their game. Games will be postponed when conditions are deemed unplayable or unsafe. We will not contact you on rain days. We will contact you if unusual situations occur. Information will also be posted at www.facebook.com/lancasterrecreation.

SCORECARDS

- 1.) The winning team will submit a scorecard complete with line-ups (first and last names), totals, hi-lites etc., in the scorecard box outside the Recreation office. If the winning team fails to submit a scorecard **by 7:00am on Saturday**, both teams will be charged with a forfeit. Hard copies, faxes, e-mails and legible photos of both sides of scorecards are acceptable.

UMPIRE PAYMENT

- 1.) Normal Game - Each team pays the umpire before the start of the game \$23.
- 2.) Games Postponed at Site by Umpire - Each team pays \$11.50
- 3.) Forfeit - Neither team pays. Full \$46 deducted from forfeiting team.

PLAYOFFS

Top four teams in divisions "B" and "C" make the playoffs. In Division "A" the first place team draws a bye while the second and third place teams play a semi-final game with the winner advancing to play the first place team in the finals. Dates, times, etc...TBA
