Guidelines:

- ✓ Posters must be created by a student who is currently in the fourth, fifth, or sixth grade.
- ✓ The poster must be related to the contest theme. This year's theme is **"How Trees Benefit People and the Environment"**. **This theme must be written on the poster.** All words must be spelled correctly.
- ✓ Posters may be done in marker, crayon, watercolor, ink, acrylic, and/or colored pencil. Computer or photo generated art is not acceptable.
- ✓ Entries must be **no smaller than 8 ½ "x 14" and no larger than 14"x18"** and should **not** be matted, mounted, laminated, framed, or folded.
- ✓ A copy of an official entry blank (on the bottom of this page) must be completed and affixed to the back of the poster. **Failure to abide by these rules will have your artwork rejected.**
